

## Presentations in Schools | Friday, the 30rd of October

Dear participants,

you will present "Tunisia" to the students of the schools BOS 1, BOS Schönbrunn and School for foreign languages (SFL). The German participants are from these schools.

Your presentations will be  
from 8:45 am to 1:00 pm in BOS SCHÖNBRUNN  
from 8:45 am to 12:15 pm in BOS 1 and SFL.

You will get a schedule with exact times for the different classes. Someone of us will escort you to the schools.

You give the same presentation in different classes. You are in teams of two and in one class you have 45 minutes. You speak English. If this is too hard of you, speak French, your partner will translate. Be aware that you need more time for interpreting.

The students know where Tunisia is located; that Tunis is the capital and that there was a revolution some years ago. They are informed about the project.

### Please mention in your introduction (10 min):

- 1) Where you live, what you do (work, student) and if you are involved in an NGO/party/social commitment.
- 2) Ben Ali – and are you glad, sad that he left your country.
- 3) Year of revolution and reasons (economic, freedom of speech)  
Mention also if you took part / or not and your attitude
- 4) The name of the current president and his background (foreign minister (?) under Ben Ali) - also your opinion about him
- 5) The last elections, the parties who are in government and that the results of the elections were accepted by a vast majority. – Have you voted? Not? Why?
- 6) The terror attacks in Museum Bardo and in Sousse  
and the reaction of the people and the consequences for Tunisia (tourism)

You are a team of two. So I recommend that you alternate from point 2) to 6).

It's possible to show slides, but I recommend NOT to do. Speak free. The students will have a map of Tunisia.

### Focus on a special topic (2 x 7 min)

After this introduction you have time to focus on a special topic like you did during the interviews in Tunis, see below the list.

### Advices

The day before Friday we will train your presentations. Important is

- 1) Look to the audience, sometime look from right to left, don't focus on one student
- 2) Link topics to German events

It's easier to follow you if the students hear a well-known fact

*"Our revolution took place 21 years after yours and like yours it was a peaceful one. But our dictator Ben Ali didn't flee to Chile like your dictator. He went to Saudi Arabia – and he's still living there."*

*“The real success is that the elections are accepted by a vast majority. For you this is normal. Nobody in German will doubt the results of elections.*

- 3) Involve your person = your attitude, your experiences or adventures, if possible
- 4) Speak free, if necessary use a paper with key words.
- 5) Don't stay behind a table or anything else.
- 6) Feel like an expert. You are the boss.
- 7) Don't "dance".
- 8) If you address your team colleague, don't say "he/she", say "you". We don't speak about persons who are present in the third person (he/she). And don't say, e.g.: "Your teacher invited us." Say: "You, Mr Name, invited us."
- 9) Say thank you that you were invited. Say thank you, for the attention.
- 10) Clarify in the beginning if the students can ask their questions during your presentation or after.
- 11) Write me your advices if you have one. Thank you.

### Questions (15 min)

During your presentation or after. If there are no questions, tell a personal story.

*“Well given that there are no questions, I like to tell you, how difficult it was for me to vote.”*
